Aside from Alfred's needs I have felt in my spirit that I was to stay close this summer and have some much needed surgery on both eyes, the surgery went well. You've heard the saying, "Look, no hands" well for me it's, "Look, no glasses", at least except for close work.

As I work even now on details for the trip I am reminded that the trip will be here before I know it. I look forward to visiting more new prison like this one in Uganda where I heard something I have heard many times before.........
